Day 1: Auckland – Waitomo – Rotorua (370kms)

This morning you will enjoy a brief sightseeing tour of Auckland before leaving the city. Travel south through the rich Waikato farming region via Ngaruawahia, home of the Maori King and Turangawaewae Marae. A short stop allows a visit to the world famous Waitomo Glow Worm Caves. Here you glide by boat through the darkness lit by thousands of tiny glowworms. Your journey continues over the bush-clad Mamaku Ranges and onto Rotorua, which is the centre of New Zealand's thermal regions. On arrival in Rotorua you'll visit Paradise Valley for a guided tour and the opportunity to view and hand feed giant trout in their natural surroundings. Following this it check-in time at your hotel.

Day 2: Rotorua

Rotorua is a truly fascinating place – where the molten lava heat beneath the earth's crust surfaces in boiling mud pools and steaming geysers. Today's sightseeing includes a morning visit to the Agrodome to see the performing sheep and a display of New Zealand's farming methods. Followed by a visit to the Whakarewarewa Thermal Reserve and Maori Arts and Crafts Institute. The remainder of the afternoon is free to relax, or to explore more of this thermal wonderland. An optional visit to the therapeutic waters of Rotorua's Polynesian Spa complex is very popular and can be arranged by your coach captain. Tonight enjoy a Maori concert and buffet dinner. Following the show it is back to your hotel for the night.

Day 3: Rotorua - Wellington (460kms)

Depart south from Rotorua through the centre of the North Island via the Huka Falls and Lake Taupo, New Zealand's largest freshwater lake. Continuing on the Desert Road past the dramatic landscape surrounding Mt Ruapehu and Mt Ngauruhoe (both of which are semiactive volcanoes) you arrive at the southern edge of the Central Volcanic Plateau around lunch-time with time or a stop at Taihape – New Zealand's gumboot throwing capital. Afterwards continue onwards over the Himatangi Plain, then down the Kapiti Coast to Wellington, New Zealand's capital city. Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Wellington including a visit to Te Papa, New Zealand's National Museum, before checking into your hotel.

Day 4: Wellington – Picton – Christchurch (360kms)

This morning you cross Cook Strait on the InterIslander ferry travelling through the Marlborough Sounds before arriving in Picton. Your coach continues en route to Christchurch past Blenheim and down the rugged East Coast via Kaikoura where you are likely to see native NZ fur seals. Once at Christchurch there is a sightseeing tour of the city and then onto your hotel to check-in.

Day 5: This morning you are free to wander the city and its activities at your leisure.
