Day #1 AUCKLAND – MELBOURNE

Approx 3 hours prior to check in time

On arrival in Melbourne, after clearing customs, please make your way to the large red Meeting Point sign to the right of the Arrivals Hall to assemble. You will then be transferred by private coach to Hotel Ibis.
