Sunday 23 May

Day #1 AUCKLAND – ADELAIDE

Approx 3 hours prior to check in time. optional metropolitan Auckland pickup service. Today, you will transfer from your designated Auckland pickup address to Auckland International Airport.

11.00 am Latest reporting time at Auckland International Airport for final check-in formalities.

1.00 pm Depart Auckland on Qantas Flight QF26 at 1.00pm.

Arrive in Melbourne @ 3.05pm Australian time.

6.50 pm Depart Melbourne on Qantas Flight QF697 at 6.10pm.
Dinner en-route
Arrive in Adelaide @ 7.00pm Australian time.

On arrival in Adelaide, after clearing customs, please make your way to the designated meeting point in the Arrivals Hall. You will then be transferred by private coach to your Hotel.

Monday 24 May

Day #2 Adelaide

Breakfast at Hotel

Following a leisurely breakfast, it is out and about in Adelaide. We will travel around the city sights, the beaches, the Cathedral and the North Terrace. From here we travel the Mount Lofty Ranges which is dotted with unique and historic villages. One of these villages is Hahndorf. This is the oldest German Settlement in Australia. Here we will explore the arts & crafts, have lunch and if you so fancy, taste the local German Brew. Following this, we will return to Adelaide during the afternoon and visit the Botanical Gardens as well as enjoying some free time in the city.

Tuesday 25 May

Day #3 Adelaide – Port Augusta

After breakfast we will spend some time at the Central City Markets. From here we will continue on to Harbour Town. Lunch at your leisure at Adelaide Harbour Town. Following breakfast we will travel around Port Augusta before heading north for Coober Pedy. Coober Pedy is a small township which has become famous for its Opals. Here you may wish to mine for your own Opals. (Optional extra) At Coober Pedy we are staying at the Desert Cave Hotel. This is Australia's only underground Hotel. (Please NO mining in the walls of your rooms). Upon arrival at Coober Pedy we will visit a local Opal Mine before we travel to The Jewel Box. This is an area where you are allowed to fossick for Opals. This is where the waste from the mines are located and many, many opals go undiscovered until they reach The Jewel Box. Good Luck.

Thursday 27 May**Day #5** Coober Pedy – Ayres Rock

Breakfast at Hotel

Today is a big day. Following breakfast, we will have a look around Coober Pedy before again heading north to the Northern Territories of Australia in search of Ayres Rock. Watch out for the Kangaroos and the other wildlife. This journey is an experience to be enjoyed. Lunch and stops as we travel upon request.

Friday 28 May**Day #6** Ayres Rock

Time for an early start today. This morning you will rise bright eyed and bushy tailed ready to watch Ayres Rock (Uluru) at sunrise. This includes breakfast.

Following this we will visit Cultural Centre to view the Arts and Crafts from the local Aboriginal Tribe. (Optional guided treks onto the rock are available. These treks are not included in our tour, but are available for those more adventurous).

The rest of the day is for you to enjoy at your leisure, or if you have so decided, to climb Ayres Rock or to ride a camel.

Shortly before sunset, journey into the desert where a didgeridoo welcomes you. As the sun sinks enjoy fine beverages and delicious outback canapés. The Sounds of Silence Dinner is not to be missed. Feast on Australian delicacies, including Emu, Kangaroo, Crocodile and Barramundi. Then relax as an astronomer guides you through the stars.

Saturday 29 May**Day #7** Ayres Rock – Alice Springs

A leisurely start to the day. For those who went trekking yesterday, a chance to rest. This morning we will travel to Alice Springs. This is pretty close to being the centre of Australia. We will get to Alice Springs mid-afternoon. Time for a swim. (Bring your swimming gear).
